<p>PAYMENT – All orders require a 25% deposit to reserve inventory. Receipt of deposit payment acknowledges acceptance of "NFN Sales Terms and Conditions". The remaining balance after receipt of deposit is due prior to shipment unless Net 30 terms have been established. Credit applications are available upon request. Credit cards are accepted for payment but will be assessed a 3% credit card processing fee. Overdue accounts will be assessed a service charge of 2.5% per month on the remaining balance due. Any accounts 60 days or more overdue will be moved to collections and buyer will then be responsible for all collection's agency fees, attorney's fees, court fees and any other fees related to collecting the overdue balance from buyer.</p>	
<p>CANCELLATIONS - Orders cancelled between September 1 and December 1 will be charged 25% of the order amount. Orders cancelled after December 1 but before February 1 of the following year will be charged 50% of the order amount. For all orders and shipping arrangements, seller's liability for damages ceases upon delivery to motor carrier.
